PLEASE NOTE:

1. Israel-based students are required to take: SWK 6003, SWK 6004, SWK 6013, SWK 6014, and SWK 6210 at HUJ.
2. Israel-based students are required to complete their field work in Israel.
3. Israel-based students are permitted to take no more than 15% of their courses online. Due to the licensure guidelines, we recommend you reserve the online option for your electives.
4. For summer 2024: students from Israel have the option to take courses in both the Summer Block I or Summer Block II. *These schedules overlap for 2 weeks in July, so please avoid time conflicts on your class schedule.*
5. The Summer Block I schedule runs from early June until the end of July.
6. The Summer Block II Hybrid Program schedule extends from the beginning of July through mid-August.
7. HUJ and Wurzweiler course schedules follow separate calendars; **start and end dates are different**. Israel-based students will be provided both calendars prior to the beginning of each fall semester.
