### **COLLECTION HIGHLIGHT**

Rabbi Judah Leib Ha-Kohen Fishman Maimon, Rabbi Meir Bar-Ilan, and Rabbi Shmuel Hayim Landau were <u>photographed in 1926 at the Arch of Titus</u>. Their decision to visit the **Arch of Titus on 9 Av**, the day of mourning for the destruction of the Temple, is symbolic. They were on their way to a Zionist conference, and wanted to make the statement that the Jewish people outlived the ancient Romans.



# ACQUISITION FOCUS: THE SCHUSSHEIM FAMILY PHOTOGRAM ALBUM

The Mendel Gottesman Library of Hebraica-Judaica recently acquired the <u>Schussheim Family photograph</u> <u>album</u>, a pictorial record of the family's travels in

Palestine in 1929. The family documented highlights of their trip in striking black and white images. This image of Rabbi Schussheim with a "Samaritan prince" will be featured in the exhibition, "<u>The Samaritans: A Biblical</u> <u>People</u>," opening at the <u>Museum of the Bible</u> in Washington, DC on September 16, 2022. The exhibition was created by the <u>Center for Israel Studies</u>, directed by <u>Steven Fine</u>, professor of Jewish History.
